29	Mr. Clark has been involved in major projects, including the
30	project to deepen and widen the Port of Mobile and the
31	Montgomery Rail Facility, which had its groundbreaking
32	ceremony in February 2025; the new facility is a partnership
33	with CSX Railroad and will serve as a hub to move
34	containerized cargo to and from the port; the project,
35	announced in 2022, has attracted over \$3 billion in economic
36	development investments from private companies; and
37	WHEREAS, the Alabama Port Authority serves all 67
38	counties in the State of Alabama and oversees the deep-water
39	public port facilities at the Port of Mobile; in addition to
40	the interstate system, the Port Authority's container,
41	general cargo, and bulk facilities have immediate access to

43	nearly 15,000 miles of inland waterways; the channel
