33	Honda Campus All-Star Challenge victories; and
34	WHEREAS, Dr. Pollard has prioritized diversity and
35	inclusion, successfully increasing Latino student enrollment
36	by 400 percent and African continental student enrollment by
37	1000 percent, while establishing the Anna Knight Center for
38	Women's Leadership Research and the Office of Diversity and
39	Inclusion; and
40	WHEREAS, under Dr. Pollard's guidance, Oakwood
41	University has transitioned to a Level V doctoral-degree
42	granting institution, with multiple new master's programs,
43	including an MSW program that launched in 2023, further
44	enhancing graduate education opportunities; and

46	philanthropic leadership, securing the largest individual
47	donation, corporate donation, and single grant award in
48	Oakwood University's history, while significantly increasing
