Witt was born in Birmingham, 6 7 Alabama, in August 1969; he is a product of the Birmingham 8 City School System, attending Powderly Elementary School, 9 Saint Mary's Catholic Elementary School, West End High 10 School, and Southern Junior College; he entered into the United States Army and served for seven years in the Persian 11 Gulf and other overseas duty stations before retiring; and 12 13 WHEREAS, after six years of membership at Zion Hill Baptist Church, Pastor Witt was ordained as a Deacon in 14 2009; he also served as Youth Director and Minister of 15 Music; during this time, he enrolled in the Birmingham 16 17 Easonian Baptist Bible College, where he served as the 18 President of Student Government Association; after several years of study, he obtained four degrees, Bible Certificate, 19 Bible Diploma, Bachelor of Arts in Theology, and Bachelor of 20 21 Arts in Pastoral Theology; and 22 WHEREAS, in 2014, Pastor Witt attained his license in June and was called to preach in December; he also moved his 23 24 membership to Shady Grove Missionary Baptist Church of Mulga 25 to serve as Youth and Associate Pastor, assisting with all 26 youth training, activities, and functions; he also served as

27 Sunday School Teacher and Reviewer, Minister to the

28 Congregation at-large on fourth Sundays or in the absence of

29 the Pastor, and aided in mission projects; he also hosted 30 the Gospel Unity Hour Program on WJLD 1400 AM Radio every 31 Sunday morning; and

32 WHEREAS, in 2016, Pastor Witt was ordained as a 33 Minister and became the Pastor of the Wheeling Chapel Missionary Baptist Church in Lipscomb, Alabama; his first 34 35 order of business was to make improvements to the structure 36 and commission a new roof; in 2022, he established the Feed 37 the Children Program of Lipscomb Elementary School and 38 started the Breakfast and Lunch Program of Brighton School's Summer Program; he also serves as the Chaplain of the City 39 40 of Lipscomb; and

41 WHEREAS, Pastor Vincent L. Witt is the former Youth 42 Director of 47 churches in Jefferson County; he's a member 43 of the Birmingham Metropolitan Minister Conference and the 44 Alabama Appleseed Center for Law and Justice; he is one of 45 the founders of the Caring Men and Caring Women, 46 Incorporated, mentoring program in Bessemer, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Pastor Witt is the 2024 recipient of the People Doing the Work Award from the MacArthur Foundation; he has been married to Sister Brenda Griggs Witt for 15 years; and he is the father of seven children and the grandfather of 12 grandchildren; now therefore,
