8	WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure, Troy
9	University's winningest coach, Larry Blakeney, is highly
10	commended and congratulated for being enshrined into the
11	College Football Hall of Fame, Class of 2025; the event will
12	take place during the 37th National Football Foundation
13	Awards Dinner; and
14	WHEREAS, Birmingham, Alabama, native and former
15	Auburn quarterback under Shug Jordan, Coach Larry Blakeney,
16	is the all-time winningest coach in both Troy University
17	(TROY) and Sun Belt Conference (SBC) history, holding a
18	20-win advantage over the next closest competitor; he now
19	becomes the first-ever player or coach in TROY or SBC
20	history to enter the College Football Hall of Fame; and
21	WHEREAS, some of Coach Blakeney's career achievements
22	include: a career record of 178-113-1, winning 61.1 percent
23	of his games in his 24 seasons at TROY; guiding the Trojans
24	to seven Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) playoff
25	appearances in eight seasons; leading the Trojans to five
26	bowl games and securing victories in 2006 and 2010; guiding
27	TROY to eight conference championships, including three in
28	the Southland Conference (SLC), before achieving an SBC

29	record of five consecutive titles from 2006-2010; and
3 0	WHEREAS, Coach Blakeney led TROY'S transition from
31	NCAA Division II to Division I in 1993 at the FCS level and
32	further led the Trojans to the Football Bowl Subdivision
33	(FBS) in 2002; he is one of only two coaches to lead a
34	program from Division II to the FBS, a feat that earned him
35	many accolades during its progression; he was named
36	conference Coach of the Year twice each in the SLC and SBC
37	and two-time American Football Coaches Association Regional
38	Coach of the Year; he has been inducted into the Wiregrass
39	Sports Hall of Fame, the Alabama Sports Hall of Fame, and
40	the inaugural class of the Troy University Sports Hall of
