36 WHEREAS, Reverend Alexander further enriched her 37 theological expertise by graduating cum laude from the 38 Academy of Public Theology at Miles College in Birmingham, 39 Alabama, while also pursuing advanced studies toward an 40 Education Specialist (Ed.S.) degree, exemplifying her 41 lifelong dedication to both academic and spiritual 42 leadership; and

WHEREAS, beyond her ministerial and academic achievements, Reverend Alexander has dedicated her career to the well-being of her community, serving as a caseworker with the Calhoun County Department of Human Resources and as a therapist at the Calhoun-Cleburne Mental Health Department, providing compassionate care and guidance to countless individuals; and
