8	in the United States being diagnosed by their 20th birthday;

10	WHEREAS, more than 190 children are diagnosed with
11	cancer annually in Alabama, and over 500 children in Alabama
12	undergo treatment each year; and
13	WHEREAS, Buckets of Smiles is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit
14	organization that was founded by Ella Kate Nichols in 2017
15	with the mission to bring a smile to the face of every child
16	fighting cancer by providing hospital-approved activity
17	items to children in Alabama hospitals; and
18	WHEREAS, Buckets of Smiles has raised over \$67,000 to
19	improve the lives of children and families affected by
20	cancer; and
21	WHEREAS, Buckets of Smiles has also created an
22	ambassador program to encourage youth throughout the United
23	States to become involved in helping others by making
24	deliveries to hospitals in their home states; and
25	WHEREAS, Buckets of Smiles has delivered over 1,588
26	buckets filled with activity items to children fighting
27	cancer across the nation; and
28	WHEREAS, Buckets of Smiles has established a college



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29	scholarship for childhood cancer survivors in the State of

31	WHEREAS, Buckets of Smiles advocates for children
32	with cancer and their families, while fundraising for
