WHEREAS, highest commendations are extended to Talladega County Commissioner Darryl Ingram for being recognized as a Willie and Betty Farrior Family Foundation Honoree for his many contributions to his community; and

WHEREAS, the foundation is named in honor of Willie Farrior, the first African American hired by the Alabama Institute for Deaf and Blind (AIDB) and the first African American to be recognized as Blind Worker of the Year in 1973; in 1974, he was promoted to training instructor and became the first Black assistant supervisor for AIDB in 1979; the foundation was established by his daughter, Mary Louise Farrior-White and grandson, Retired Colonel Cedrick A. Farrior; the foundation recognizes certain individuals who have selflessly contributed their time for the betterment of their community; and

WHEREAS, Darryl Ingram was born in Eastaboga, Alabama; Darryl is a graduate of Lincoln High School and attended Jacksonville State University; he is married to Rebecca Armbruster Ingram, and they have one son; Darryl enjoys spending time with his family, all sports, and is an avid cyclist in his personal time; and
