8 WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure,  
9 Mountain Brook Chief of Police, James A. "Jaye" Loggins, is  
10 highly commended for his many professional achievements  
11 during his 29-year career on the occasion of his retirement;

13 WHEREAS, Chief Loggins began his career with the  
14 Mountain Brook Police Department in 1996 after completing  
15 the Alabama Advanced Criminal Justice Academy at the  
16 Montgomery Police Department; over the course of his career,  
17 he has served and supervised in every division throughout  
18 the department, which includes patrol, investigations, and  
19 administration; he was promoted to executive management and  
20 had oversight of the daily operations of the agency at the  
21 ranks of Captain and Deputy Chief; and

22 WHEREAS, Jaye Loggins was named Chief of Police on  
23 October 25, 2021; under his leadership, the department  
24 implemented a take-home vehicle program; transitioned  
25 dispatch services to Shelby County 911; increased the  
26 award-winning School Resource Officer team and cultivated a  
27 collaborative partnership with the Mountain Brook School  
28 System; adopted new, advanced technical investigative

29 capabilities; and invested in positive community relations  
30 through programs and events, including the first annual  
31 Community Night Out; and the Mountain Brook First Responders  
32 Foundation was created during his tenure; and

33 WHEREAS, Chief Loggins has worked to increase his  
34 knowledge and skills, having completed the Alabama Public  
35 Safety Leadership Academy and the Managers Preparing to  
36 Accomplish Change Today program; as a member of the Tactical  
37 Operations Unit, he received advanced training at the  
38 federal, state, and local levels as a Certified Tactical  
39 Operator; and he completed the FBI Law Enforcement Executive  
40 Development Seminar; additionally, he completed all  
41 requirements to attain the prestigious Certified Law  
42 Enforcement Executive designation as recognized by the  
43 Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission  
44 and the Alabama Association of Chiefs of Police; and

45 WHEREAS, Chief Loggins earned many awards and  
46 accolades over the years, some of which include the FBI Law  
47 Enforcement Executive Development Academy Trilogy Award,  
48 being named Officer of the Year in 1998 and 2006, and the  
49 Safest Cities Award for 2024; and

50 WHEREAS, before becoming a police officer, Jaye  
51 Loggins attended The University of Alabama at Birmingham and  
52 earned a Bachelor of Science in Justice Science in 2001; in  
53 2022, he earned a Master's Degree in Criminal Justice from  
54 Jacksonville State University; he has steadfastly served and  
55 protected the residents of Mountain Brook leaving a lasting  
56 legacy of excellence and community involvement; now
