9	Relating to conservation; Alabama Good Samaritan
10	Wildlife Rehabilitation Act established to authorize
11	individuals to provide care to injured or orphaned wild birds
12	and animals under certain conditions.
13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as
15	the Alabama Good Samaritan Wildlife Rehabilitation Act.
16	Section 2. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,
17	an individual may in good faith provide care or treatment to
18	sustain life or reduce disability to any injured, orphaned, or
19	debilitated wild bird or animal that is not federally
20	protected or otherwise endangered so that the organism may be
21	returned to the wild subject to all of the following:
22	(1) The individual shall provide to the Wildlife and
23	Freshwater Fisheries Division of the Department of
24	Conservation and Natural Resources the dates on which care or
25	treatment begins and ends.
26	(2) The length of care or treatment of a wild bird or
27	animal may not exceed six months.
28	(3) A wild bird or animal shall be returned to the

	(b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to do
eithe	r of the following:
	(1) Authorize an individual engaged in wildlife
rehab	ilitation to engage in the practice of veterinary
medic	ine as defined in Section 34-29-61, Code of Alabama 197
	(2) Exempt an individual from the crime of cruelty to
anima	ls as provided in Section 13A-11-14, Code of Alabama
1975.	
	(c) The Department of Conservation and Natural
<mark>Resou</mark>	rces shall adopt rules to administer this section.
	Section 3. This act shall become effective on October
