5	This bill would provide that a criminal

11	misdemeanor where the victim was a minor shall be
12	sentenced to a Class C felony.

19	Relating to crimes and offenses; to provide that a
20	defendant who is an illegal alien who is convicted of a
21	criminal offense must receive an enhanced sentence in certain
22	circumstances.
23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
24	Section 1. (a) For the purpose of this section "illegal
25	alien" means an individual not entitled to lawfully reside or
26	work in the United States.
27	(b) In all cases when it is shown that a criminal
28	defendant, who is an illegal alien, has been convicted of a



29 felony where the victim is a minor, he or she must be punished 30 as follows:

31 (1) On a conviction of a Class D felony, for a Class C32 felony.

33 (2) On a conviction of a Class C felony, for a Class B34 felony.

35 (3) On a conviction of a Class B felony, for a Class A36 felony.

37 (4) On a conviction of a Class A felony, by
38 imprisonment for life or for any term of not more than 99
39 years, but not less than 15 years.

40 (c) In all cases when it is shown that a criminal
41 defendant, who is an illegal alien, has been convicted of a
42 misdemeanor offense where the victim is a minor, he or she
43 shall be punished for a Class C felony.

44 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October45 1, 2025.
