13	venues; and to repeal Section 16-27-2, Code of Alabama 1975,
14	requiring the buses to transport community college and trade
15	school students under certain circumstances.
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
17	Section 1. Section 16-27-1 of the Code of Alabama 1975,
18	is amended to read as follows:
19	" §16-27-1
20	The State Board of Education shall prescribe adopt
21	rules and regulations :
22	(1) Requiring all local boards of education which
23	provide transportation services for pupils students going to
24	and from public elementary and secondary schools of Alabama or
25	in school-related activities, and the presidents of all state
26	community, junior and technical colleges and directors of all
27	state technical institutes and trade schools which provide
28	transportation services for pupils going to and from said

- technical institutes and trade schools or community, junior and technical colleges to employ a competent supervisor or manager of such the transportation services, whether such the transportation services are provided in publicly owned or privately owned buses; (2) Requiring periodic safety inspection of all vehicles used for transporting pupils students, whether such the vehicles are publicly or privately owned; (3) Requiring and providing for special training and licensing of drivers of all vehicles used to transport pupils students to and from school and in all school-related activities, whether such the vehicles are publicly owned and operated or operated under contract with a private owner-; and (4) Requiring each local board of education to adopt a policy regarding transportation services available for enrolled students including, but not limited to, dual enrollment students at community and technical college campuses or other offsite educational venues, and students attending career technical education centers." Section 2. Section 16-27-2 of the Code of Alabama 1975, requiring public school buses to provide transportation to community college and trade school students under certain circumstances, is repealed.
- Section 3. This act shall become effective on June 1, 2025.
