4 Relating to crimes and offenses; to amend Section
5 13A-10-11, Code of Alabama 1975, to include additional
6 activity that would constitute the crime of impersonating a
7 peace officer.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Section 13A-10-11, Code of Alabama 1975, is
10 amended to read as follows:

11 "§13A-10-11

12 (a) A person commits the crime of impersonating a peace
13 officer if he or she does any of the following:

14 (1) ~~falsely~~ Falsely pretends to be a peace officer and
15 does any act in that capacity.

16 (2) Is employed as or otherwise accepts an appointment
17 as a peace officer either:

18 a. Knowing that he or she is not eligible to serve as a
19 peace officer under the laws of this state; or

20 b. Knowing that his or her certification with the
21 Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission has
22 been revoked or suspended.

23 (3) Employs, appoints, or otherwise facilitates a
24 person serving as a peace officer when he or she knows the
25 person is prohibited from serving as a peace officer under
26 subdivision (2).

27 (b) Impersonating a peace officer is a Class C felony.

28 (c) For the purposes of this section, "peace officer"

29 includes any officer or employee of the federal government
30 vested by law with a duty to maintain public order or to make
31 arrests for crimes, whether that duty extends to all crimes or
32 is limited to specific crimes."

33 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
34 1, 2025.
