3 Relating to Calhoun County; to amend Section 45-8-110,
4 Code of Alabama 1975; to further provide for the compensation
5 of the board of registrars.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. Section 45-8-110, Code of Alabama 1975, is
8 amended to read as follows:

9 "§45-8-110

10 (a) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to
11 the contrary, ~~in the Calhoun County,~~ Commission shall pay each
12 member of the board of registrars ~~shall receive~~ additional
13 compensation in the amount of fifteen dollars (\$15) per day
14 for each day's attendance upon business of the board, on days
15 the board is authorized to meet and conduct business, to be
16 ~~paid by the county commission~~ out of the county general fund
17 ~~of the county treasury~~. Such amount shall be in addition to
18 any and all other amounts provided for by law.

19 (2) The Calhoun County Commission, by resolution, may
20 increase the additional compensation authorized in subdivision
21 (1).

22 (b) If implementation of ~~the compensation in this~~
23 ~~section~~ subsection (a) increases the compensation of an
24 incumbent office holder and is prohibited by the Constitution
25 of Alabama of ~~1901, as amended~~ 2022, or otherwise by law, the
26 increase shall be paid as an expense allowance until the
27 beginning of the next term of office whereupon the amount of
28 the expense allowance shall be included in the compensation

29 for the office holder and the expense allowance shall be
30 voided."

31 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
32 1, 2025.
