9	Relating to Calhoun County; to amend Section 45-8-110,
10	Code of Alabama 1975; to further provide for the compensation
11	of the board of registrars.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. Section 45-8-110, Code of Alabama 1975, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	"\$45-8-110
16	(a) (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to
17	the contrary, <u>in the</u> Calhoun County, <u>Commission shall pay</u> each
18	member of the board of registrars shall receive additional
19	compensation in the amount of fifteen dollars (\$15) per day
20	for each day's attendance upon business of the board, on days
21	the board is authorized to meet and conduct business, to be
22	paid by the county commission out of the <u>county</u> general fund
23	of the county treasury. Such amount shall be in addition to
24	any and all other amounts provided for by law.
25	(2) The Calhoun County Commission, by resolution, may
26	increase the additional compensation authorized in subdivision
27	(1).
28	(b) If implementation of the compensation in this

section subsection (a) increases the compensation of an 29 30 incumbent office holder and is prohibited by the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended 2022, or otherwise by law, the 31 32 increase shall be paid as an expense allowance until the 33 beginning of the next term of office whereupon the amount of 34 the expense allowance shall be included in the compensation 35 for the office holder and the expense allowance shall be 36 voided."

37 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October38 1, 2025.
