1 Enrolled, An Act,

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4 Relating to foreign national driver licenses; to amend
5 Section 32-6-10.1, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide that
6 foreign national driver licenses may not be used as photo
7 identification for voting purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. Section 32-6-10.1, Code of Alabama 1975, is
10 amended to read as follows:

11 "§32-6-10.1

12 (a) For the purposes of this section, the following
13 terms have the following meanings:

14 (1) FOREIGN NATIONAL. An individual who is not a
15 citizen of the United States.

16 (2) LICENSE. An Alabama driver license, non-driver
17 identification card, or vessel license.

18 (b) The application for a license to be issued to a
19 foreign national shall contain, in addition to the information
20 on the established application, the applicant's country of
21 origin and the expiration date of the acceptable form of
22 immigration documentation as outlined in this section.

23 (c) Applications for a foreign national license shall
24 be processed only at driver license offices designated by the
25 Secretary of the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency.

26 (d) The license issued to a foreign national shall
27 include a designation that the license is issued to a foreign
28 national in a manner set forth by the Secretary of the Alabama

29 State Law Enforcement Agency on the license. The designation
30 shall distinguish between foreign nationals with lawful
31 permanent residence in the United States and foreign nationals
32 whose authorized period of stay in the United States is
33 temporary.

34 (e) The license issued to a foreign national shall
35 expire on the date of the expiration of the acceptable form of
36 immigration documentation provided at the time of application.

37 (f) In order for a foreign national to renew his or her
38 license, the applicant must re-initiate the licensing process
39 in the same manner as a first-time applicant.

40 (g) Under no circumstances shall the agency issue a
41 license for a period of less than 30 days.

42 (h) A license issued pursuant to this section may not
43 be presented or accepted for purposes of complying with
44 Section 17-9-30.

45 ~~(h)~~ (i) The Secretary of the Alabama State Law
46 Enforcement Agency shall adopt rules concerning the
47 enforcement of this section."

48 Section 2. This act shall become effective June 1,
49 2025.
