1 Enrolled, An Act,

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3 Relating to Marshall County; to amend Section 45-48-161
4 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to provide further for the
5 distribution of in-lieu-of-taxes payments of the Tennessee
6 Valley Authority.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. Section 45-48-161 of the Code of Alabama
9 1975, is amended to read as follows:

10 "§45-48-161

11 In each fiscal year, the distribution of the share of
12 in-lieu-of-taxes payments of the Tennessee Valley Authority
13 for Marshall County shall be as follows:

14 (1) Twenty-five percent of the total amount allocated
15 to Marshall County shall be distributed to the Marshall County
16 Board of Education, the Arab City Board of Education, the
17 Guntersville City Board of Education, the Albertville City
18 Board of Education, and the Boaz City Board of Education, on a
19 per pupil basis based upon the student enrollment of the
20 respective schools on the last day of the first monthly
21 attendance report of each school year.

22 (2)a. ~~Four percent of the remaining 75 percent~~ or two
23 hundred forty thousand dollars (\$240,000), whichever is
24 greater, shall be allocated for the operation of the Marshall
25 County Legislative Delegation Office.

26 b. Any funds not expended for the operation of the
27 legislative office may be used for educational purposes or
28 industrial or economic development projects in Marshall County



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29 as approved by unanimous consent of the legislative
30 delegation.

31 (3) The remaining ~~71 percent~~ funds shall be allocated
32 as provided herein and shall be reviewed by the county
33 legislative delegation every four years.

34 a.1. Six percent of the remaining ~~71 percent~~ funds or
35 ~~two hundred thirty two thousand dollars (\$232,000)~~ two hundred
36 forty-seven thousand dollars (\$247,000), whichever is greater,
37 shall be allocated to the Marshall County Economic Development
38 Office. These ~~moneys~~ monies shall be used to employ a director
39 and staff and to carry out the operation of recruiting
40 industries and job opportunities for Marshall County and each
41 of the municipalities in the county. The director shall be
42 employed by the Economic Development Board.

43 2. All money previously allocated to the Marshall
44 County Economic Development Board which is accumulated and
45 held in a designated fund for industrial or economic
46 development projects in Marshall County is released for
47 further allocation at the direction of the board.

48 b. Thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) shall be allocated
49 to the Marshall County Commission to help provide for school
50 resource officers in the Marshall County school system.

51 ~~c. Fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) shall be~~
52 ~~allocated to the Marshall County Economic Development Board in~~
53 ~~addition to the allocation in paragraph a.~~

54 ~~d.c.~~ d.c. Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) shall be
55 allocated to the Mountain Valley Council on the Arts
56 ~~commencing on October 1, 2006.~~



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57 ~~e.d.~~ Thirteen thousand dollars (\$13,000) shall be
58 allocated to the City of Albertville for ambulance use so long
59 as the ambulance service is provided by the city; and
60 ~~twenty-seven thousand dollars (\$27,000)~~ thirteen thousand
61 dollars (\$13,000) shall be allocated to the City of ~~Arab~~ Boaz
62 for ambulance use so long as the ambulance service is provided
63 by the city.

64 ~~f.e.~~ Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) shall be
65 allocated to Mountain Lakes Behavioral Health Care, for mental
66 health services, including substance abuse treatment and
67 prevention.

68 ~~g.f.~~ Eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) shall be
69 allocated to the Marshall County Convention and Visitors
70 Bureau.

71 ~~h.g.~~ Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) shall be
72 allocated to the Marshall County Coalition Against Domestic
73 Violence.

74 ~~i.h.~~ Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) shall be
75 allocated to CASA of Marshall County, Inc., for services to
76 the aging and homebound.

77 ~~j.i.~~ Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) shall be
78 allocated to the Marshall County RSVP.

79 j. Twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) shall be
80 allocated to Snead State Community College.

81 (4) All remaining amounts after the preceding
82 allocations shall be paid to the county governing body to be
83 distributed to the county and municipalities as provided by
84 law."



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85 Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,
86 2025.
