4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, the Governor is authorized
6	to appoint an individual to fill a vacancy in the
7	office of Attorney General, State Auditor, Secretary of
8	State, State Treasurer, and Commissioner of Agriculture
9	and Industries.
10	This bill would propose an amendment to the
11	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to authorize the
12	Governor to fill a vacancy in the office of Lieutenant
13	Governor.

20	Proposing an amendment to Section 136 of the
21	Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to the filling of
22	vacancies by the Governor; to authorize the Governor to
23	appoint an individual to fill a vacancy in the office of
24	Lieutenant Governor.
25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
27	of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:

29 "Sec. 136

30 Should the office of Lieutenant Governor, 31 attorney-general, state auditor, secretary of state, state 32 treasurer, or commissioner of agriculture and industries 33 become vacant from any cause, the governor shall fill such 34 vacancy until the disability is removed or a successor elected 35 and qualified. In case any of said officers shall become of 36 unsound mind, such unsoundness shall be ascertained by the supreme court upon the suggestion of the governor." 37

Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the 38 39 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional 40 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions: 41 42 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation 43 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise 44 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize 45 46 language; and translate effective dates.

END OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT

48 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 49 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 50 Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this 51 state. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot 52 number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the 53 election ballot and shall set forth the following description 54 of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment: 55

Proposed by Act ." 59 60 This description shall be followed by the following 61 language: 62 "Yes() No()." 63 Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as a part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved. 64
