4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, commissions consisting of
6	associations of producers of a specific agriculture
7	commodity may be certified by the Alabama Department of
8	Agriculture and Industries to conduct a referendum on
9	levying an assessment to promote the respective
10	commodity that members of the association produce.
11	This bill would increase the levy that may be
12	assessed on the sale of a cotton bale.
13	This bill would also make nonsubstantive,
14	technical revisions to update the existing code
15	language to current style.

19	TO BE ENTITLED
20	AN ACT

22	Relating to agriculture; to amend Section 2-8-199, Code
23	of Alabama 1975, to increase the levy that may be assessed on
24	the sale of cotton bales; and to make nonsubstantive,
25	technical revisions to update the existing code language to
26	current style.
27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
28	Section 1. Section 2-8-199, Code of Alabama 1975, is



29 amended to read as follows:

30 "§2-8-199

31 <u>(a)</u> If in the referendum a majority or more of the 32 cotton producers who are eligible to participate and who 33 actually vote therein, shall vote in the affirmative and in 34 favor of the levying and collection of collecting the 35 assessment proposed in the referendum, then the assessment 36 shall be levied on a per bale basis and collected in the 37 manner hereinafter provided.

38 (b) All cotton producers who produced cotton in the 39 crop year immediately preceding the referendum shall be 40 eligible to may participate in the referendum. Following the 41 referendum and within 30 days thereafter, the certified 42 commission shall canvass, tabulate, and publicly declare and 43 announce the results thereof.

44 <u>(c)</u> The assessment levied upon the sale of cotton-shall 45 <u>may</u> not exceed one dollar <u>and thirty cents</u> (\$1) (\$1.30) per 46 bale. The commission shall determine the assessment amount on 47 an annual basis."

48 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October49 1, 2025.
