1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to Mobile County; to further provide for the
4 compensation of the judge of probate; and to repeal Act
5 443-1967, 1967 Regular Session, relating to the compensation
6 of the judge of probate.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. (a) Until January 20, 2031, the Mobile
9 County Judge of Probate shall continue to receive the same
10 base annual salary the judge of probate is receiving on
11 February 1, 2025.

12 (b) Beginning June 1, 2025, in addition to the base
13 salary authorized in subsection (a), the judge of probate
14 shall receive an expense allowance of forty-nine thousand
15 dollars (\$49,000) per annum, payable in equal monthly
16 installments from the county general fund.

17 (c) Beginning January 20, 2031, the judge of probate's
18 base salary authorized in subsection (a) shall be increased by
19 forty-nine thousand dollars (\$49,000) per annum and the
20 expense allowance authorized in subsection (b) is repealed.

21 (d) (1) Beginning June 1, 2025, the judge of probate
22 shall be entitled to all uniform increases in compensation
23 provided to county employees.

24 (2) The amount of any uniform increase granted to the
25 judge of probate shall be based on the judge of probate's
26 total compensation.

27 (3) Any uniform increase in compensation granted to the
28 judge of probate during a term of office shall be paid as an

29 expense allowance until the start of the next term of office.

30 (4) At the beginning of each term of office, any
31 uniform increase in compensation provided to the judge of
32 probate during the previous term of office shall be converted
33 to salary and any converted expense allowance is repealed.

34 (5) Any expense allowance provided pursuant to this
35 section shall be treated as salary for retirement purposes.

36 Section 2. Act 443, 1967 Regular Session (Acts 1967,
37 p. 1116), relating to the compensation of the Judge of Probate
38 of Mobile County, is repealed.

39 Section 3. This act shall become effective on June 1,
40 2025.
