5	This bill would prohibit a law enforcement
6	officer from using a taser on a restrained individual.

10	TO BE ENTITLED
11	AN ACT

13	Relating to criminal procedure; to prohibit a law
14	enforcement officer from using a taser on a restrained
15	individual.
16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
17	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the
18	term "taser" means any mechanism that is designed to emit or
19	project an electronic, magnetic, or other type of charge or
20	shock for the purpose of temporarily incapacitating an
21	individual.
22	(b) Notwithstanding Section 13A-3-27, Code of Alabama
23	1975, a law enforcement officer shall not use a taser on an
24	individual who is restrained or otherwise unable to resist,
25	including when an individual has been placed in handcuffs,
26	body cuffs, or any other restraining device.
27	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
28	1, 2025.
