- Relating to Etowah County and the Mega Sports Complex
- 4 Authority; to amend Section 45-28-220.03, Code of Alabama
- 5 1975, to immediately transfer all fiduciary responsibility
- 6 relating to the authority to the City of Rainbow City; and to
- 7 provide for the dissolution of the authority upon the full
- 8 payment of certain outstanding debt.
- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 10 Section 1. Section 45-28-220.03 of the Code of Alabama
- 11 1975, is amended to read as follows:
- 12 "\$45-28-220.03
- 13 (a) This section shall only apply in Etowah County.
- 14 (b) The Etowah County Mega Sports Complex Authority is
- 15 created.
- 16 (c) (1) Immediately after October 1, 2022, the terms of
- 17 the members serving on the authority shall end. Thereafter,
- 18 the The authority shall consist of the following members:
- a. Except as otherwise provided in subparagraph 1., one
- 20 member appointed by each member of the local legislative
- 21 delegation with initial terms expiring as follows:
- 1. House District 29, expiring November 10, 2022. The
- 23 initial appointment occurring after October 1, 2022, shall be
- 24 made by the Director of the Etowah County Tourism Board.
- 25 Subsequent appointments to this position shall be made by the
- legislative member representing House District 29.
- 2. House District 28, expiring November 10, 2023.
- 3. House District 30, expiring November 10, 2024.



- 4. Senate District 10, expiring November 10, 2025.
- 30 b. The President of the Etowah County Chamber of 31 Commerce, or his or her designee.
- 32 c. The Director of the Etowah County Tourism Board, or 33 his or her designee.
- d. One member appointed by the governing body of the
  City of Rainbow City, for an initial term expiring November
  10, 2024.

- (2) Upon completion of the initial staggered terms, subsequent appointments of non ex-officio members shall be made in the same manner for terms of four years.
- (3) A member shall be removed from the authority after failing to attend three consecutive properly noticed regular meetings of the authority, or more than half of the properly noticed regular meetings, during a calendar year. The members of the authority shall meet at least quarterly and minutes of the meetings of the authority shall be posted on a website operated by the authority or on a social media website of the authority, or both, within 30 days after the meeting date. A vacancy on the authority for any reason shall be filled by appointment by the original appointing authority for the unexpired term.
- (4) Except for the Director of the Etowah County

  Tourism Board, no member of the authority may also serve as a

  member of the Etowah County Tourism Board.
  - (d) The authority shall evaluate the development of a sports complex for Etowah County for implementation and administration by the authority. The evaluation shall include,



57	but is not limited to, the following considerations and

59	(1) The feasibility of a mega sports complex for the
60	county.
61	(2) What should be included in such a complex.
62	(3) The location of such a complex.
63	(4) The cost associated with acquiring and maintaining
64	such a complex.
65	(5) Possible funding sources for such a complex.
66	(e) After its evaluation, the authority may initiate
67	the development and management of a public mega sports complex
68	in the county.
69	(f)(d) The authority, subject to subsections (e) and
70	(h), shall—also have the following powers and duties:
71	(1) To acquire or lease real property for the
72	development of sports or other recreational facilities and
73	related improvements for public purposes.
74	(2) To make, enter into, and execute contracts,
75	agreements, or other instruments necessary to accomplish the
76	purposes of this section.
77	(3) To establish and appoint committees and hire staff
78	which it deems necessary for the carrying out of its
79	functions.
80	(4) To accept and receive any and all donations and
81	grants of money, equipment, supplies, materials, and services,
82	and to receive, utilize, and dispose of it.

(5) To perform other functions as may be necessary or appropriate to achieve the purposes of this section.

85	(e) Commencing on October 1, 2025, all fiduciary
86	responsibility and duties relating to the authority shall be
87	vested in the City of Rainbow City. All revenue of the
88	authority including, but not limited to, tax revenues received
89	pursuant to Section 45-28-220.03, shall be transmitted to the
90	appropriate designated division of the city and all fiscal
91	distributions, liabilities, and obligations of the authority
92	shall be the responsibility of the city, provided that
93	collected and received revenue is sufficient to satisfy the
94	liabilities and obligations of the authority. The designated
95	division shall have unfettered access to all accounts held by
96	the authority on October 1, 2025, which accounts shall remain
97	separate and distinct from all other accounts held by the
98	city.
99	(g) (f) All T.V.A. in-lieu-of-taxes payments to Etowah
100	County retained by the county and not transferred to the City
101	of Sardis pursuant to Section 40-28-2 shall be distributed to
102	the Etowah County Mega Sports Complex Authority to be used for
103	the financing and operation of a mega sports complex as
104	provided by the City of Rainbow City pursuant to subsection
105	<u>(e)</u> .
106	(h)(g)(1) Any additional funds received by the
107	authority from any state or county tax revenue shall be
108	applied first toward the payment of existing debts.
109	(2) Immediately upon the full payment of all debts in
110	existence as of October 1, 2022, all revenues referenced in
111	subsection (g) (f) of this section and subdivision (1) of
112	Section $45-28-91$ $02(1)$ shall be held in the county treasury



- until otherwise directed by unanimous consent of the members of the legislative delegation.
- (h) On or before June 1, 2048, and immediately upon the
- full payment of all debts in existence on October 1, 2022, the
- terms of the members then serving on the authority pursuant to
- 118 subsection (c) shall end, and the authority shall be
- 119 dissolved. At that time, the City of Rainbow City shall
- 120 perform all duties of the authority as provided in subsection
- 121 (d) and all existing debts, liabilities, and assets of the
- 122 authority including, but not limited to, real property,
- buildings, equipment, and other assets, shall transfer to the
- 124 <u>City of Rainbow City.</u>
- 125 (i) A comprehensive financial audit of the authority
- shall be performed immediately after October 1, 2022, annually
- for the immediately succeeding two years, and every two years
- 128 thereafter. The audit shall be performed by a licensed
- independent certified public accountant chosen by the
- authority from a list of three auditing firms nominated by the
- 131 governing body of the City of Rainbow City. A copy of each
- audit performed shall be submitted to the Chief Examiner of
- 133 the Department of Examiners of Public Accounts and each
- appointing authority within 30 days after completion.
- 135 Immediately upon dissolution of the authority, the
- 136 comprehensive financial audits shall cease."
- 137 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
- 138 1, 2025.
