- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 8 Section 1. (a) Any municipality within Coffee County 9 may contract with the Sheriff of Coffee County for police services. The contract may include enforcement by the sheriff, 10 11 or his or her duly commissioned deputies, of all laws within the corporate limits and police jurisdiction of the 12 13 municipality, including municipal ordinances, and the arrest 14 or citation of any offenders as if the sheriff, or his or her 15 duly commissioned deputies, were duly constituted police 16 officers of the municipality.
 - (b) A municipality entering into a contract pursuant to subsection (a) shall pay to the county treasury a sum sufficient to provide the necessary manpower and equipment as mutually agreed upon by the municipal governing body, the sheriff, and the county commission.
 - (c) The county commission shall receive from the municipality the funds paid under the contract for police services and may expend funds for police services in the municipality, including the police jurisdiction of the municipality.
 - (d) Each contract between the sheriff and a municipality shall be with the consent and approval of the
