1 Enrolled, An Act,

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To adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975, 4 5 those general and permanent laws of the state enacted during 6 the 2024 Regular Session, as contained in the 2024 Cumulative Supplements to certain volumes of the code and 2025 7 8 Replacement Volumes 16A, 18, and 18A; and to adopt and 9 incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975, the 2024 Cumulative Supplements to local law volumes; to initially adopt and 10 11 incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975, Volume 22N 12 (Revised), Local Laws, Pickens through Russell Counties; to 13 make corrections in certain volumes of the cumulative 14 supplements and replacement volumes; to specify that this 15 adoption and incorporation constitute a continuous systematic 16 codification of the entire Code of Alabama 1975, and that this act is a law that adopts a code; to declare that the Code 17 18 Publisher has certified that it has discharged its duties 19 regarding the replacement volumes; to expressly provide that 20 this act does not affect any 2025 session statutes; and to 21 specify the duties of the Secretary of State regarding the 22 custody of the cumulative supplements and replacement volumes. 23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Those general and permanent laws of the state enacted during the 2024 Regular Session as contained in the 2024 Cumulative Supplements to Volumes 3 to 16, inclusive, Volumes 17 to 17B, inclusive, and Volumes 19 to 22A, inclusive, and the 2025 Replacement Volumes 16A, 18, and 18A,



- and the additions and deletions made by the Code Commissioner
- for editorial purposes, as edited and published by Thomson
- 31 Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of the 2024
- 32 Cumulative Supplements and 2025 Replacement Volumes 16A, 18,
- and 18A are identified and authenticated by the Great Seal of
- 34 the State of Alabama placed upon the front and back of each of
- 35 the volumes of the cumulative supplements and upon the first
- 36 inside page and the last inside page of the replacement
- 37 volumes, are adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama
- 38 1975.

To delete 65 Section 45-30-60 in its entirety, as this section was repealed 66 67 by implication in Sections 1 and 2 of Act 2024-269. Section 2. Those local and permanent laws of the state 68 previously enacted and contained in initial Volume 22N 69 70 (Revised), Local Laws, Pickens through Russell Counties, and 71 the local and permanent laws pertaining to various counties enacted during the 2024 Regular Session, as contained in the 72 73 2024 Cumulative Supplements to Volumes 22B, 22C, 22D, 22E, 74 22F, 22G, 22H, 22I, 22J, 22K, 22L, and 22M, and the 2024 75 Regular Session additions and deletions made by the Code 76 Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and published 77 by Thomson Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of 78 the 2024 Cumulative Supplements are identified and 79 authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed 80 upon the front and back of each of the volumes of the 81 cumulative supplements, are adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama 1975. 82 83
 - Section 3. The adoption and incorporation of the supplements and replacement volumes specified in this act

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85 shall constitute a continuous systematic codification of the 86 entire Code of Alabama 1975, for purposes of Section 85 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022. This act is a law that adopts 87 88 a code for the purposes of Section 45 of the Constitution of 89 Alabama of 2022. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in 90 this act shall be deemed to codify any provision of law that 91 was adopted in violation of any provision of the Constitution 92 of Alabama of 2022, establishing requirements for, or limitations on, the enactment of a law. 93 Section 4. It is declared that Thomson Reuters, as the 94 95 Code Publisher, has certified that it has discharged its duties and responsibilities to edit and publish 2025 96 97 Replacement Volumes 16A, 18, and 18A of the Code of Alabama 98 1975, by combining the material in the previous bound volumes 99 with the material contained in the cumulative supplements without making substantive changes, but making, under the 100 101 supervision and pursuant to the direction of the Code 102 Commissioner, nonsubstantive changes and corrections as may 103 have resulted from changes in reference numbers, changes of 104 names and titles of governmental departments, agencies, and 105 officers, typographical errors, grammatical changes, and 106 misspellings.

Section 5. The adoption of this act shall not repeal, supersede, amend, or in any other way affect any statute enacted into law during any 2025 session of the Legislature.

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
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Section 6. Upon passage and approval of this act, the duly authenticated volumes of the 2024 Cumulative Supplements and the 2025 Replacement Volumes 16A, 18, and 18A shall be





113	transmitted to the Secretary of State, who shall file the
114	volumes of the supplements and the replacement volumes in that
115	office. The volumes of the supplements and replacement volumes
116	shall not be removed from the Office of the Secretary of
117	State, but the Secretary of State, upon request, under proper
118	certificate and seal of that office, shall certify any part or
119	parts thereof upon payment of the fee specified by law for
120	similar services.
121	Section 7. This act shall become effective immediately.
