SYNOPSIS:

This bill would propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to Montgomery County, to provide that members of the Montgomery County Board of Education serve two-year terms.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to Montgomery County, to amend Section 51-5.00 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to further provide for the terms of office of the Montgomery County Board of Education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Section 51-5.00 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, is amended to read as follows:

"§51-5.00

As terms of office on the Montgomery County Board of Education expire, new members shall be elected to the board

29 for terms of ~~four~~two years."

30 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the
31 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as
32 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional
33 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:
34 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation
35 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest
36 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise
37 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize
38 language; and translate effective dates.

39 END PROPOSED AMENDMENT

40 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
41 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285
42 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws
43 of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign
44 a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on
45 the election ballot and shall set forth the following
46 description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed
47 constitutional amendment:

48 "Relating to Montgomery County, proposing an amendment
49 to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to provide that
50 members of the Montgomery County Board of Education serve
51 two-year terms.

52 Proposed by Act ____."

53 This description shall be followed by the following
54 language:

55 "Yes() No()."

56 Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as

57 part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by
58 a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
