30 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the 31 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as 32 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional 33 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions: change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation 34 35 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest 36 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise 37 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize language; and translate effective dates. 38

END PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Relating to Montgomery County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to provide that members of the Montgomery County Board of Education serve two-year terms.

- This description shall be followed by the following language:
- "Yes() No()."
- Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as
