4	SYNOPSIS:
5	This bill would require the Alabama Medicaid
6	Agency to cover any noninvasive colorectal cancer
7	screening test assigned a grade A or B under the
8	recommendations of the United States Preventive
9	Services Task Force.
10	This bill would also require the Alabama
11	Medicaid Agency to cover a colonoscopy based on a
12	positive test result.

15	A BILL
16	TO BE ENTITLED
17	AN ACT

19	Relating to the Alabama Medicaid Agency; to require the
20	agency to cover certain noninvasive colorectal screening tests
21	under certain conditions; and to require the Medicaid Agency
22	to cover a colonoscopy based on a positive test result.
23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
24	Section 1. The Alabama Medicaid Agency shall provide
25	coverage for any noninvasive colorectal cancer screening test
26	that is assigned a grade A or B under recommendations of the
27	United States Preventive Services Task Force, as the
28	recommendations of the task force may be amended from time to

time. The Medicaid Agency shall also provide coverage for any 29 30 colonoscopy performed based on a positive screening test result. Coverage of the tests shall include, but not be 31 32 limited to, all of the following tests, provided the test 33 maintains a grade A or B rating based on recommendations of 34 the task force: (1) The guaiac fecal occult blood test (gFOBT). 35 36 (2) The fecal immunochemical test (FIT). (3) The multi-target stool DNA test (sDNA-FIT). 37 Section 2. This act shall be effective immediately. 38
