1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama
4 of 2022, relating to the City of Montgomery, to allow the city
5 council to participate in the Employees' Retirement System of
6 Alabama.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution
9 of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:

10 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

11 The elected or appointed members of the governing body
12 of the City of Montgomery may participate in the Employees'
13 Retirement System of Alabama upon the same terms and
14 conditions as may be specified by law for any other employee
15 in the same retirement system and shall be treated as
16 employees of the city. A member holding office at the time of
17 the ratification of this amendment may purchase service credit
18 in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama for the time
19 the official has served as a member. No individual may
20 participate in both a supernumerary program and the Employees'
21 Retirement System of Alabama.

22 Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the
23 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as
24 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional
25 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:
26 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation
27 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest
28 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise

internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize language; and translate effective dates.

END PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, relating to Montgomery County, to authorize the members of the Montgomery City Council to participate in the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama.

Proposed by Act ____."

This description shall be followed by the following language:

"Yes() No()."

Section 3. The proposed amendment shall become valid as part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
