18	Section 9-10B-7, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide that the
19	division chief is an employee in the exempt service; and to
20	further provide for the division chief's duties and functions.
21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
22	Section 1. "§9-10B-7
23	The Office of Water Resources shall be headed managed
24	by and shall be under the direction, supervision, and control
25	of an officer who shall be known and designated as the
26	Division Chief of the Alabama Office of Water Resources. The
27	division chief $\underline{\text{who}}$ shall be appointed by the director, with
28	the approval of the Governor, and shall report to, and be

29	under the direct supervision of, the director. The division
30	chief shall carry out the functions and duties of the Office
31	of Water Resources. The division chief shall be a person an
32	<pre>individual knowledgeable in the fields of water resource</pre>
33	management, development, and conservation. The division chief
34	shall be a state Merit System employee. The salary of the
35	division chief shall be set in accordance with state law.
36	Vacancies in the position of division chief shall be filled in
37	the same manner as set forth above; provided, however, that
38	prior to the appointment and approval of a division chief, the
39	director may appoint an acting division chief or may assume
40	the responsibilities of, and serve in the capacity as,
41	division chief until a division chief is selected in
42	accordance with the provisions of this chapter The division
43	<pre>chief shall be employed in the exempt service."</pre>
44	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
45	1, 2025.
