5	This bill would require individuals in
6	possession of a firearm to secure the firearm in a

22	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
23	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the
24	following terms have the following meanings:
25	(1) FIREARM. The same meaning as provided in Section
26	13A-8-1, Code of Alabama 1975.
27	(2) UNAUTHORIZED PERSON. Any individual whom a
28	possessor of a firearm has not authorized to possess the

- firearm or any individual not legally permitted to possess a particular firearm under state or federal law.
- 31 (b) An individual shall at all times secure a firearm 32 in his or her possession, control, care, or custody in a
- 33 manner and location where the individual knows, or reasonably
- 34 should know, that an unauthorized person is not likely to gain
- 35 access to the firearm.
- 36 (c) A violation of subsection (b) is a Class C felony.
- 37 (d) Neither of the following shall be construed to have
- 38 been stored in violation of subsection (b):
- 39 (1) A firearm stored with a gun lock.
- 40 (2) A firearm carried on one's person.
- 41 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
- 42 1, 2025.
