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9	Relating to public highways; to amend Section 23-1-4,
10	Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for the issuance of a
11	permit for access to certain state rights-of-way on public
12	highways; to provide certain permit processing deadlines for
13	applications by electric providers; and to authorize
14	associated condemnation actions to be expedited.
15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
16	Section 1. Section 23-1-4, Code of Alabama 1975, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	"§23-1-4
19	(a) The Legislature of Alabama finds and declares the
20	following:
21	(1) Electric transmission infrastructure is critical to
22	the economic growth and well-being of this state and Alabama
23	has an immediate need to expand and facilitate such investment
24	for the benefit of its residents.
25	(2) Public rights-of-way provide essential corridors
26	and paths for electric transmission infrastructure.
27	(3) Prompt issuance of permits for electric
28	transmission infrastructure of electric providers in public



29 rights-of-way will provide the needed support to industrial 30 growth, job creation, and economic development, particularly 31 in rural and underserved areas. 32 (b) No state-controlled road shall be dug up or used 33 for laying pipelines, pole lines, sewers, railways, or for 34 other similar purposes without the written permit of the State 35 Department of Transportation, and such the work shall be done 36 only in accordance with the regulations prescribed by the 37 department, and the. (c) The permittee shall pay the cost of replacing the 38 39 road in as good condition as it was before such the permitted work was done shall be paid by the person, firm, or 40 corporation to whom or in whose behalf such permit was given. 41 42 Such person, firm, or corporation so desiring such workAn 43 applicant for a permit under this section shall furnish the state with a cash deposit or certified check upon a solvent 44 45 bank or surety bond in from a guaranty company qualified to do 46 business in Alabama, in the amount required by the State 47 Department of Transportation department, conditioned that the sum is to be forfeited to the state in the event that said the 48 49 road is not placed in as good condition as it was prior to 50 said the permitted work being done, within 15 business days 51 from the time said the permitted work is completed. 52 (d) (1) Upon the receipt of an application of an 53 electric provider for a permit relating to electric 54 transmission facilities, the department shall determine whether the application is complete. If the application is not 55

complete, the department, within 14 business days after

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57	receiving the application, shall respond to the applicant in
58	writing with a description of any deficiency in the
59	application.
60	(2) Within 35 business days after receiving from an
61	electric provider a completed application for a permit
62	relating to electric transmission facilities, the department
63	shall approve or deny the application; provided, however, the
64	department may exercise a one-time, 10-business-day extension
65	for its consideration of the application for a permit upon
66	written notice to the applicant.
67	(3) Unless waived by the applicant, if the department
68	fails to approve or deny the application for a permit within
69	the required period under subdivision (2), the requested
70	permit shall be deemed approved by the department upon the
71	posting of the deposit or bond required by subsection (c).
72	(4) In the event that the application for a permit is
73	denied, the applicant, within 10 business days, may request
74	review by the director, in which event the director, within 10
75	business days, shall render a decision in writing either
76	affirming or reversing the permit denial, along with the
77	reasons for any permit denial.
78	(e) Nothing in this section shall be construed to
79	require the department to acquire rights-of-way to accommodate
80	an electric provider's electric transmission facilities.
81	(f)(1) For purposes of this section, "electric
82	provider" has the same meaning as provided in Section 37-16-3.
83	The term includes the Tennessee Valley Authority and includes
84	an authority as defined in Section 11-50A-1.



85	(2) For purposes of this section, "electric
86	transmission facilities" means facilities distributing or
87	transmitting electricity at voltages of 40,000 volts or
88	greater."
89	Section 2. In any condemnation action tangential to an
90	application for a permit under Section 23-1-4, Code of Alabama
91	1975, on motion from the plaintiff, the circuit court shall
92	enter an order assigning the case to the expedited track and
93	shall ensure resolution as expeditiously as feasible.
94	Section 3. This act shall become effective on October
95	1, 2025.
