1 Enrolled, An Act,

3 Relating to Shelby County; to authorize the county
4 commission to levy an additional motor vehicle license and
5 registration issuance fee; and to provide for distribution of
6 the proceeds.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. (a) (1) The Shelby County Commission may levy
9 and provide for the collection of an annual additional motor
10 vehicle license and registration issuance fee in the amount of
11 up to two dollars (\$2) on each new registration, transfer, or
12 renewal on any vehicle in the county with the motor vehicle
13 license and registration year commencing on January 1
14 following the commission's levy of the new fee.

15 (2) The fee authorized by this section may only be for
16 one continuing annual fee of up to two dollars (\$2).

17 (3) The county's license issuing official shall collect
18 the issuance fee on each new registration, transfer, or
19 renewal on a vehicle in the county.

20 (4) The fee shall be in addition to all other fees,
21 taxes, or other charges provided for the license and
22 registration of a vehicle.

23 (b) The license issuing official, on a monthly basis,
24 shall distribute the proceeds from this section to the
25 Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund to be used for law enforcement
26 purposes in the county.

27 (c) Any fee established pursuant to this section and
28 the use of the proceeds from such a fee shall not diminish or

29 take the place of any other source of income established for
30 the sheriff or the operation of the sheriff's office.

31 Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,
32 2025.
