| 16 | there shall be taxed a fee as follows: |
| 17 | (1) Twenty-five dollars (\$25) in each civil case filed |

| 20 | (2) Twenty-five dollars (\$25) in all misdemeanor and |
| 21 | felony criminal cases, including traffic offenses, upon |
| 22 | conviction. |

- on the same schedule as other similar audits.
- 37 (d)(1) The sheriff shall certify to the county
- 38 commission each employee who has engaged in hazardous duty and
