SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, the filling and distributing of liquefied petroleum gas is regulated by the Alabama Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board.

This bill would prohibit permittees of the board from filling or storing LP-Gas cylinders for retail sale within a certain distance of public gathering places.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board; to add Section 9-17-111 to the Code of Alabama 1975, to prohibit permittees from filling or storing LP-Gas cylinders within a certain distance of public gathering places.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 9-17-111 is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

§9-17-111

No permittee may fill a liquefied petroleum gas cylinder for retail sale or store a filled liquefied petroleum gas cylinder for distribution for retail sale within 3,000
