5	This bill would require each public high school
6	student to receive instruction in violence prevention,
7	conflict resolution, and mediation before graduation.
8	This bill would also require the State
9	Department of Education to develop standards relating
10	to the teaching of violence prevention, conflict
11	resolution, and mediation pursuant to a course or
12	program of instruction.

17	AN ACT
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19	Relating to public education; to require instruction in
20	violence prevention, conflict resolution, and mediation before
21	graduation from high school; and to require the State
22	Department of Education to develop standards for a course or
23	program encompassing that instruction.
24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. Section 16-40-13 is added to the Code of
26	Alabama 1975, to read as follows:
27	§16-40-13
28	(a) Beginning with public school students entering

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- 29 ninth grade in the 2026-2027 school year, each student shall
- 30 complete a course or program in violence prevention, conflict
- 31 resolution, and mediation before graduation from high school.
- 32 The instruction shall include a discussion of or instruction
- 33 in all of the following:
- 34 (1) Responsible decision-making.
- 35 (2) The causes and effects of school violence and
- 36 harassment, cultural diversity, and nonviolent methods for
- 37 resolving conflict, including peer mediation.
- 38 (3) The consequences of violent behavior.
- 39 (4) The causes of violent reactions to conflict.
- 40 (5) Nonviolent conflict resolution techniques.
- 41 (6) The relationship between drugs, alcohol, and
- 42 violence.
- 43 (7) The implementation of voluntary peer mediation
- 44 programs and the integration of conflict resolution models in
- 45 classrooms.
- 46 (b) Before June 30, 2026, the State Department of
- 47 Education shall prepare and make available to all local boards
- 48 of education instructional materials, models, and curricula
- 49 that may be used as guidelines for development of a violence
- 50 prevention, conflict resolution, and mediation course or
- 51 program. Each local board of education shall determine the
- 52 appropriate curriculum for satisfying the requirements of this
- 53 section. The State Department of Education shall assist in
- 54 training teachers to provide effective instruction in violence
- 55 prevention, conflict resolution, and mediation.
- 56 (c) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules as



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- 57 necessary to implement this section.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
- 59 1, 2025.
