6	WHEREAS, the Alabama Senate takes great pride in
7	recognizing and supporting the heroes of the State of
8	Alabama who have selflessly labored in their fight against
9	injustice; and
10	WHEREAS, December 1 marks the anniversary of Rosa
11	Parks' historic 1955 arrest after she courageously refused
12	to relinquish her seat on a Montgomery city bus to a white
13	male passenger; this act of defiance sparked the Montgomery
14	Bus Boycott, a pivotal movement led by the African American
15	community that resulted in the desegregation of Montgomery's
16	public bus system; and
17	WHEREAS, Mrs. Parks demonstrated not only her morals
18	and ethics relating to discrimination, but also the value of
19	life and equality; and
20	WHEREAS, in the rightful commemoration of the life of
21	Mrs. Rosa Parks, each individual can become an ethical and
22	moral leader through his or her decisions, recognizing and
23	understanding his or her values, and having the resolve to
24	follow through with them; and
25	WHEREAS, the Rosa Parks Day Act is proposed
26	legislation that would designate December 1 as a federal
27	holiday commemorating the historic arrest of Rosa Parks; it
28	is vital to the success of the State of Alabama to support
