7	are herein proudly extended to Miss Abbie Stockard for being
8	crowned 2025 Miss America during the annual Miss America
9	competition on January 5, 2025, at the Walt Disney Theater
10	in Orlando, Florida; and
11	WHEREAS, Abbie Stockard's brilliance dazzled the
12	judges and crowd at the 2025 Miss America Competition where
13	she earned her prestigious title through hard work,
14	diligence, admirable ambition, and a commitment to serve;

16	WHEREAS, the 22-year-old Auburn University nursing
17	student and dance team member, crowned Miss Alabama in June
18	2024, is dedicated to advancing her career by pursuing a
19	Doctorate of Nurse Anesthesia Practice with a focus on
20	pediatrics, combining her passion for health care and
21	children; and
22	WHEREAS, Abbie, an active member of the Alpha Gamma
23	Delta sorority at Auburn University, has spent three years
24	with the Tiger Paws dance team, performing at Auburn's
25	various sports events; she began dancing at age 2, training
26	at the Jackie O'Neal School of Dance and later at Birmingham
27	Dance Theatre; for both the Miss Alabama and Miss America
28	competitions, Abbie showcased her talent with a contemporary

29 routine to Lauren Daigle's "You Say," a performance inspired 30 by the memory of her late grandmother; and

31 WHEREAS, Abbie, in line with Miss America's 32 distinguished philanthropic initiatives, serves as a Best 33 Buddies Champion and Mission Partner; she has raised more 34 than \$5,000 for the American Heart Association (AHA) and was 35 honored with the AHA Go Red for Women Leadership Award at 36 the Miss America Competition; and

37 WHEREAS, a passionate advocate for Cystic Fibrosis 38 (CF) inspired by her best friend, Maddie Hagler, Abbie was named the "2024 Hero of Hope" and appointed the "Official 39 National Ambassador" for the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation 40 41 during her reign as Miss America; she has raised over 42 \$200,000 for CF research, partnered with national 43 researchers, including Doctor George Solomon, a pulmonologist at The Kirklin Clinic of UAB Hospital, and led 44 45 Alabama's largest CF fundraiser, declaring, "I will not stop 46 until the 'CF' in Cystic Fibrosis stands for Cure Found!"; 47 Abbie has also collaborated with state and national leaders, notably Senator Jabo Waggoner, to advance CF legislation and 48 49 continues to use her platform to champion the cause and 50 empower women in leadership; and

51 WHEREAS, Abbie holds a deep appreciation for her 52 hometown of Vestavia Hills, where she attended high school 53 and found numerous opportunities to engage with and 54 positively impact her community; she values the tight-knit 55 nature of the town, where people have strong connections and 56 support one another; outside of her responsibilities as Miss

57 America, Abbie enjoys spending time outdoors, often going 58 hiking to connect with nature; and

59 WHEREAS, Abbie is the daughter of proud parents Brad 60 and Kim Stockard of Vestavia Hills; she shares a special 61 bond with her twin brother, Bradley, and her younger sister, 62 Lilly; both Abbie and Bradley are pursuing their nursing 63 degrees at Auburn University, while Lilly began her freshman 64 year at Auburn this fall; and

65 WHEREAS, Miss Stockard is an intelligent and gifted 66 leader whose willingness to serve others and actions to make 67 the world a better place reflect immense credit upon the 68 entire State of Alabama, and she is truly deserving of the 69 significant honor bestowed upon her; now therefore,
