20 Justice Training in Selma in 2006; he then attended Alabama
21 Southern Community College where he earned an Associate of

23 Criminal Justice in 2014; he also earned two Master of
24 Science Degrees in Justice Administration in 2017 and
25 Management in 2020 from Faulkner University; and

26 WHEREAS, serving as a highly respected member of
27 Governor Kay Ivey's security detail since 2019, Justin
28 Williams consistently demonstrated exceptional
