5    SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, AND THE UNITED STATES SECRETARY OF THE  
6    AIR FORCE TO ESTABLISH A PERMANENT HEADQUARTERS FOR UNITED  
7    STATES SPACE COMMAND AT REDSTONE ARSENAL IN HUNTSVILLE,  
8    ALABAMA.

10            WHEREAS, in 2021, the United States Air Force  
11    announced Redstone Arsenal in Huntsville, Alabama, as the  
12    preferred location for the United States Space Command  
13    Headquarters; and

14            WHEREAS, in determining where to permanently locate  
15    the United States Space Command Headquarters, Redstone  
16    Arsenal in Huntsville, Alabama, consistently ranked as the  
17    top location throughout the selection process and compared  
18    more favorably across four key factors and 21 criteria than  
19    any other finalist location; and

20            WHEREAS, the results of the Strategic Basing Action  
21    found that Huntsville, more so than any other finalist  
22    location, provided a large, qualified workforce, quality  
23    schools, superior infrastructure, and low initial and  
24    recurring costs to the Department of Defense; and

25            WHEREAS, the results of the Strategic Basing Action  
26    prove that Redstone Arsenal in Huntsville, Alabama, was and  
27    remains the best location for the headquarters of the United  
28    States Space Command, and it was the informed decision of

the Department of the Air Force to select the site as the preferred location on January 13, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the findings of the Strategic Basing Action have been supported by reports following subsequent Department of Defense Inspector General and Government Accountability Office investigations; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That this body recognizes that the United States Air Force's Strategic Basing Action process complied with the law and policy and was justified in identifying Huntsville as the preferred permanent location for the United States Space Command Headquarters to ensure the national security and fiscal responsibility of the United States and well-being of service members and their families.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That we encourage the President of the United States, the United States Secretary of Defense, and the United States Secretary of the Air Force to immediately proceed in establishing a permanent headquarters for United States Space Command at Redstone Arsenal in Huntsville.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be delivered to the President of the United States, the United States Secretary of Defense, the United States Secretary of the Air Force, and the Alabama Congressional Delegation.
