7 WHEREAS, in 2006, President George W. Bush designated 8 the month of June as Caribbean American Heritage Month to 9 raise awareness of the contributions that Caribbean 10 Americans have made to the United States and to celebrate 11 the rich and diverse cultural and historical influence of 12 the island nations, including music, food, and traditions; 13 and

14 WHEREAS, Caribbean people have been a part of the 15 history of the United States since its founding as a Nation; 16 Alexander Hamilton, from Nevis and St. Kitts, was a founding 17 father and the first Secretary of the Treasury; Jean 18 Baptiste Point du Sable, from Haiti, was the founder of the 19 City of Chicago; and Jacob de Cordova, a Jewish Jamaican, 20 was instrumental in the founding of Waco, Texas; and

21 WHEREAS, other notable Caribbean people and 22 descendants of Caribbean immigrants include Harry Belafonte, 23 Cicely Tyson, Eric Holder, Sheryl Lee Ralph, General Colin 24 Powell, Shirley Chisolm, Una Clarke, and former Vice 25 President Kamala Harris, all of whom have contributed to the 26 nation in the areas of politics, medicine, entertainment, 27 sports, and many other fields; and
