9	Small Business Week; and
10	WHEREAS, we celebrate the multitude of products,
11	resolve, and ingenuity of American small businesses,
12	entrepreneurs, and workers; and
13	WHEREAS, American small businesses have been critical
14	in revitalizing economically distressed areas; and
15	WHEREAS, our nation's small businesses are at the
16	very core of our free market and prosperity, creating and
17	providing jobs and benefits to workers and their families;

19	WHEREAS, with over 449,024 small businesses in the
20	State of Alabama, small business owners employ 46.7 percent
21	of the state's private sector workforce, and small
22	businesses account for 99.4 percent of Alabama businesses;

24	WHEREAS, over the last 25 years, Alabama small
25	business employment has grown by nearly 10 percent; and
26	WHEREAS, small businesses in the United States employ
27	half of the workforce of the United States and make up 99.7
28	percent of all employees in the United States; and

29 WHEREAS, exports by small businesses reached \$648.5 30 billion, making up 35.7 percent of the exports of the United States, and Alabama small firms exported goods worth over 31 32 \$4.4 billion; and 33 WHEREAS, 8.1 percent of all Alabama small business 34 owners are Veterans; and 35 WHEREAS, women make up 47.5 percent of Alabama small 36 business workers and own 45.1 percent of small businesses in 37 our state; and 38 WHEREAS, minorities make up 32 percent of Alabama workers and own 26.4 percent of businesses in our state; and 39 40 WHEREAS, two out of every three new jobs in the 41 United States are created by small businesses; now 42 therefore, 43 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we support the week of May 44 45 4-10, 2025, as National Small Business Week; we encourage 46 all residents of Alabama to: (1) celebrate the entrepreneurial spirit of small business owners in Alabama 47 and our nation who have chartered their own course to 48 49 provide jobs and bright futures for millions of American 50 workers; (2) understand the importance of creating a small business climate that allows for sustained economic 51 52 recovery; (3) celebrate the invaluable contribution that 53 small businesses make to the United States and to Alabama as 54 the backbone of the economy; (4) support increasing consumer 55 awareness of the value and opportunity that small businesses
