1 2 3 4 SJR COMMENDING THE COOK MUSEUM OF NATURAL SCIENCE. 5 WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure, 6 7 highest commendations are conveyed to the Cook Museum of 8 Natural Science in support of their mission to introduce the 9 natural world to students of all ages in North Alabama; and 10 WHEREAS, the Cook Museum of Natural Science began in 1968 when John Cook, Sr. opened his professional insect 11 collection to the public by appointment; and 12 WHEREAS, the Cook family, in 2016, expressed their 13 14 vision of the museum as a more engaging, exciting, and educational experience for the next generation; the new Cook 15 16 Museum of Natural Science reopened as a nonprofit 17 organization on June 7, 2019; and 18 WHEREAS, today, the Cook Museum of Natural Science is 19 a 62,000 square foot, state-of-the-art natural science museum with STEM classrooms and an exhibition space that 20 21 holds nine themed galleries, providing a hands-on, immersive 22 experience where kids can explore, interact with, and learn about nature; some of the highlights that museum guests can 23 24 experience include an immersive cave experience; live 25 animals, including baby alligators, lizards, snakes, insects, jellyfish, fresh and saltwater fish, an endangered 26 27 Kemp's ridley sea turtle; a forest exhibit with a climbing tree; and much more; and 28

29 WHEREAS, since its opening in 2019, the museum has 30 partnered with North Alabama schools to bring students to its STEM classrooms; during 2023, the museum's total number 31 32 of visitors was 85,626 which includes 16,243 students from 33 72 cities and 19 Alabama counties; those numbers increased to 86,725, with 18,764 of those being students from 90 34 35 cities and 21 Alabama counties; the program is so successful 36 and enriching for the students that the museum has plans to raise funds to expand its STEM program; now therefore, 37
