4	SYNOPSIS:
5	This bill would require an unexpired
6	manufacturer's warranty on a heating, ventilation, and
7	air-conditioning system to be transferred to any new
8	owner upon the conveyance of the associated real
9	property.

12	A BILL
13	TO BE ENTITLED
14	AN ACT

16	Relating to consumer protection; to regulate the
17	transfer of unexpired manufacturer's warranties on heating,
18	ventilation, and air-conditioning systems with the associated
19	real property.
20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
21	Section 1. (a) As used in this section, the following
22	terms have the following meanings:
23	(1) HVAC SYSTEM. A heating, ventilation, and air
24	conditioning system.
25	(2) MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY. The original equipment
26	manufacturer's unregistered, initial, or base term warranty to
27	repair, service, or replace a component or a part of the HVAC
28	system that automatically accompanies the HVAC system at the



- 29 time of purchase, through no further action of the owner. The
- 30 term does not include any coverage extended beyond the
- 31 unregistered, initial term or base warranty.
- 32 (3) RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY. Any of the following:
- a. A single-family house.
- b. A duplex, triplex, or quadraplex.
- 35 c. A unit in a multi-unit residential structure in
- 36 which title to an individual unit is transferred to the owner
- of the unit under a condominium or cooperative system.
- 38 (b) If a residential real property that includes an
- 39 HVAC system as a fixture to the property is conveyed to a new
- 40 owner on or after October 1, 2025, a manufacturer's warranty
- in effect on that system or a component of that system:
- 42 (1) Is automatically transferred to the new owner; and
- 43 (2) Continues in effect as if the new owner was the
- 44 original purchaser of such system or component, as applicable.
- 45 (c) A warrantor continues to be obligated under the
- 46 terms of a manufacturer's warranty agreement for a warranty
- 47 transferred under this section and may not charge a fee for
- 48 the transfer of the warranty.
- (d) The transfer of a manufacturer's warranty under
- 50 this section does not extend the remaining term of the
- 51 warranty.
- 52 (e) This section applies if:
- 53 (1) A sale of a residential property that includes an
- 54 HVAC system as a fixture to the property occurs on or after
- 55 October 1, 2025;
- 56 (2) A manufacturer's warranty is still in effect on the



- 57 HVAC system or a component of the system; and
- 58 (3) A warranty agreement was entered into or renewed on
- or after October 1, 2025. A warranty agreement entered into or
- for renewed before October 1, 2025, is governed by the law in
- effect on the date the agreement was entered into or renewed,
- and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
- 64 1, 2025.
