17 d. A seat belt for each passenger.

18 e. A roll bar.

19 f. A manufacturer-installed or equivalent spark
20 arrester.

21 g. A manufacturer-installed or equivalent muffler in
22 proper working order and properly connected to the
23 vehicle's exhaust system.

24 h. A windshield, with or without wipers.

(2) If a vehicle is certified by an off-road vehicle dealer as meeting the requirements of subdivision (1), the local licensing official, on application of the owner of the vehicle and payment of all applicable fees, shall register and issue a tag for the vehicle pursuant to Article 2 of Chapter 6 of Title 32, Code of Alabama 1975. The tag shall be securely attached in the same manner as a private passenger vehicle and shall indicate that the off-road vehicle is for restricted use.

(3) The off-road vehicle shall be covered by a liability insurance

violation of this section is guilty of a traffic infraction.

(k) The mere use of an off-road vehicle pursuant to this section shall not be evidence of product misuse, contributory negligence, or assumption of the risk.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on January 1, 2026.
