4 SYNOPSIS:

5                   Under existing law, termination dates are  
6                   established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies  
7                   are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset  
8                   Committee. After the review process is completed, the  
9                   committee prepares its recommendation for the agencies  
10                  to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which  
11                  either continue, terminate, or continue with  
12                  modification each agency reviewed.

13                  This bill would provide for the continuance of  
14                  the Alabama Construction Recruitment Institute until  
15                  October 1, 2028, with the following changes: To require  
16                  the Alabama Construction Recruitment Institute, the  
17                  Alabama Department of Workforce, and other interested  
18                  parties to determine options for the institute to  
19                  better utilize the administrative and operational  
20                  services of the department.

27                  Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the  
28                  existence and functioning of the Alabama Construction



29 Recruitment Institute until October 1, 2028, with certain  
30 modifications; to require the Alabama Construction Recruitment  
31 Institute, the Alabama Department of Workforce, and other  
32 interested parties to determine options for the institute to  
33 better utilize the administrative and operational services of  
34 the department.

35 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

36         Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the  
37 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama  
38 Construction Recruitment Institute until October 1, 2028, with  
39 additional recommendation for statutory change as set out in  
40 Section 3.

41         Section 2. The existence and functioning of the  
42 Alabama Construction Recruitment Institute, created and  
43 functioning pursuant to Sections 41-10-720 to 41-10-732,  
44 inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1  
45 2028, and those code sections are expressly preserved.

46         Section 3. The Alabama Construction Recruitment  
47 Institute, the Alabama Department of Workforce, and other  
48 interested parties shall convene to evaluate and determine  
49 options to enable the institute to utilize the administrative  
50 and operational resources of the department. A report shall be  
51 prepared detailing these findings and submitted to the Chair  
52 of the Sunset Committee and other members of the Legislature  
53 as deemed appropriate not later than the tenth legislative day  
54 of the 2027 Regular Session, at which point all parties shall  
55 be absolved of their duties and shall cease meeting.

56         Section 4. The Legislature concurs in the



57 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in  
58 Sections 1, 2, and 3.

59 Section 5. This act shall become effective on June 1,  
60 2026.
