Senate Bill 147 as introduced could increase receipts, by undetermined amounts, to the Public Safety Fund and the Public Road and Bridge Fund from civil traffic citations issued by the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA) in the amount of \$200, to persons recorded speeding by an automated photographic speed enforcement system in a construction zone; and could decrease receipts, by a corresponding amount to the State General Fund.

Additionally, this bill could increase receipts to the State General Fund and the county general funds to which court costs are deposited dependent on the number of people determined to be liable for a construction zone speeding violation after an adjudicative hearing or that failed to appear for an adjudicative hearing for the speeding violation.

Finally, this bill could increase the obligations to the Alabama Department of Transportation (DOT) for the installation of automated speed enforcement systems in construction zones on public highways, depending on the number of automated speed enforcement systems installed. Per the department the cost for automated speed enforcement system placed in a work zone can range from \$200,000-\$400,000, depending on the length of the construction project.
