Senate Bill 138 as passed the Senate could increase receipts to the State General Fund by an undetermined amount from civil penalties, imposed on franchisors for violating the provisions of this bill in amounts ranging from \$10,000 for a first violation to up to \$50,000 for subsequent violations. In addition, this bill could increase receipts to the State General Fund, county general funds, municipal general funds, and other funds to which court costs are deposited dependent upon the number of persons charged with violating the provisions of this bill and the penalties imposed.
