House Bill 511 as reported by the Committee on State Government proposes a constitutional amendment which, if ratified, could reduce funding to local public K-12 boards of education by an undetermined amount dependent on the amount of funds that are withheld for failure of the local board to adopt a policy that requires the public schools under its jurisdiction to conduct the Pledge of Allegiance and conduct a prayer at the commencement of the first class each school day.

Additionally, this bill will increase the proclamation expenses of the Governor, paid from the State General Fund, by an estimated \$100,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2027.
