House Bill 511 as passed the House of Representatives proposes a constitutional amendment which, if ratified, would require local boards of education to adopt policies requiring each public K-12 school under its jurisdiction to conduct the Pledge of Allegiance at the beginning of the school day and to allow prayer to be conducted pursuant to the provision of this amendment.

Additionally, this bill will increase the proclamation expenses of the Governor, paid from the State General Fund, by an estimated \$100,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2027.
