Senate Bill 272 as reported by the Committee on Judiciary could increase the administrative obligations of the State Board of Education to adopt rules regarding the use of public records provided by local boards of education.

Additionally, this bill could increase the administrative obligations of certain government agencies to comply with the provisions of this bill to redact certain information from public contracts for goods or services that could be used to initiate a financial transaction.

Additionally this bill could increase the obligations of the Attorney General's Office and prosecuting authorities by an undetermined amount to seek action against persons violating the provisions of this bill, which could likewise increase receipts to the State General Fund and to local funds by an undetermined amount dependent upon the number of violations and the amount of penalties imposed, for violating the provisions of this bill in amounts not to exceed \$500 per violation.
