### House Bill 233

**House Bill 233** as introduced would increase the obligations of the Alabama National Guard Education Assistance Program (ANGEAP) by an undetermined amount dependent on any tuition assistance provided for: (1) accredited and non-accredited but approved certification or stand-alone training as part of a workforce development program; and (2) required on-campus living expenses or meal plans.

Additionally, this bill would decrease potential obligations of the ANGEAP by an undetermined amount dependent on the difference in: (1) payments for tuition, fees, ancillary costs, and costs of required on-campus living expenses and meal plans at an amount not to exceed the median cost of tuition per term of all public four-year institutions of higher education in the state; and (2) payments made under current law. For the 2025-26 school year the median cost of tuition per term is \$12,454.

The Governor's recommended Education Trust Fund budget for FY 2027 would appropriate \$9,831,114 to the ANGEAP.
